

Recycling Guidelines



Note: Please cover bin on rainy or snowy days to keep paper recyclables dry.

What goes in the Chippewa Falls recycling bin:

Rigid Containers

Place your metal (tin) cans, glass bottles and plastic bottles loosely in your recycling bin on a commingled basis - no separation is required! **DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS OR CARDBOARD BOXES.** All containers should be rinsed clean and lids removed.

Steel (Tin) Cans

Aluminum Cans

Glass Bottles & Jars

- No window glass, light bulbs, mirrors, ceramics or other glass

#1 & #2 Plastic Bottles

- Examples: soda bottles, milk jugs and laundry detergent bottles
DO NOT INCLUDE #3-#7 PLASTICS
(No ice cream pails or cool whip containers)



What goes in a separate plastic bin:

Paper Products

Place the following paper materials loosely in a separate plastic bin. **DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS OR CARDBOARD BOXES. DO NOT MIX WITH METAL CANS, GLASS BOTTLES, PLASTIC BOTTLES AND ALUMINUM CANS.**

Magazines & Catalogues

Newspapers

Phone Books

Paper Grocery Bags

Mixed Paper

- Junk Mail (remove any plastic)
- Books
- Envelopes (window, labeled, kraft)
- Office paper (white, colored, ledger, NCR, fax)
- File folders
- Glue pads, tablets

Corrugated Cardboard

Flatten all cardboard. If convenient, cut into 2' x 2' sections and place beside bin. Secure cardboard from the wind.

▣ - Appliances, Hazardous Waste, Computers, Tires, and Scrap Metal

* - Yard Waste Site

Residents may dispose of yard waste (leaves, grass clippings, and small brush) at the Chippewa Falls City Shop at Riverside Drive on designated days. For more information regarding the yard waste site please call 720-6971.

▲ - Waste Oil

Waste motor oil should be disposed of properly at the following location. Recycle engine oil only. Do not mix the oil with any other substances such as antifreeze or paint thinner. Take your empty containers home with you.
