Transportation, Construction, Public Safety and Traffic

Committee #3 met Monday, May 19, 2014 at 3:30 pm in the City Hall Council Chambers, 30 West Central Street, Chippewa Falls, WI.

Council/Committee Members present: Mike Hanke and Bill Hicks.

Others present: City Clerk Bridget Givens, Sensitive Crimes Investigator Deborah Brettingen, Utilities Office Manager Connie Freagon, members of the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Juniors Girl Scout Troop, and Troop Leader Karrie Meier.

The meeting was called to order at 3:30 pm.

- 1. Meet with the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Juniors Girl Scout Troop from Hillcrest Elementary to discuss possible ideas to fulfill their Bronze Award requirements by making positive changes in their community. Possible recommendations to Council.**

Members of the Girl Scout Troop came forward to express their desire to place a stop sign at the intersection of Terrill Street and Bel Air Boulevard. There have been five accidents with two injuries reported at that intersection in the last ten years. The extent of the injuries is unknown.

Based upon this location being in a school zone, the Committee thought a stop sign would be merited. Investigator Brettingen indicated it may be necessary to install a three-way stop at the intersection.

Further discussion ensued regarding the timeline to complete the process, the girls being involved with installation of the signs if approved, and options for payment. The Troop indicated their desire to help with cost by using proceeds from cookie sales.
