Committee #3

Transportation, Construction, Public Safety and Traffic

Committee #3 met Monday, September 22, 2014 at 7:00 pm in the City Hall Council Chambers.
30 West Central Street, Chippewa Falls, WI.

Council/Committee Members present: Mike Hanke, Amy Mason, Paul Olson, George Adrian, and Chuck Hull.
Others present: Police Chief Wendy Stelter, City Clerk Bridget Givens, Bernard Lavelle, Heather Marble and Nina Eisold.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

1. Discuss Street Use Permit Application from Sweeney's Bar & Grill, Dewey's Roadhouse, Burly's, and Weekend at Bernie's for Trick-or Treat on Canal Street on November 1, 2014. Possible recommendations to the Council.

The taverns on Canal Street are requesting to have barriers put up to stop vehicular traffic for their upcoming event. Chief Stelter indicated that she always accounts for two extra officers for this event; but thought that based upon the street closure, music, and extension of premises requests, two officers would not be enough and an additional four officers would be required.

It was discussed that the live music would begin at 6:00 pm and conclude at 9:00 pm. The temporary beer garden areas would be open from 5:00 pm - 10:30 pm and road barriers would be up prior to allow for set-up. Patrons would not be allowed to consume alcohol when walking between the establishments; alcohol would only be permitted in the temporary beer garden areas. The taverns will have the street, sidewalks, and boulevards cleaned by noon the following day.

Councilor Hanke expressed concern with the additional expense to the City to cover for the extra officers and questioned if the taverns would be open to covering the costs. The tavern representatives indicated they have hired additional security staff for the event and did not feel they could shoulder the additional expense of the officers. Chief Stelter thought that six officers would be required from 5:00 pm - 10:00 pm, and four officers from 5:00 pm - 3:00 pm equating to roughly \$1,200 in overtime costs. Councilor Mason indicated she would like to hear from the residents in the area to determine if they have issues with the event. It was recommended that a public hearing be held on October 7th with the tavern representatives in attendance to answer any questions that may arise.

Chief Stelter thought that additional staff would be required as this is the first time this event is being extended into the street. She is not sure of the amount of people that will be in attendance and wants to promote a successful event.

Motion by Hanke/Mason to move this item forward to Council with the condition that a public hearing is set prior to the Council's vote on the item and a security plan is put in place and approved by the Chippewa Falls Police Department, resulting in zero fiscal impact to the City for any extra police officers. **All present voting aye, motion carried.**

2. Discuss possible extension of premises in relation to the current Alcohol Beverage Licenses of Sweeney's Bar & Grill, Dewey's Roadhouse, Burly's, and Weekend at Bernie's for Trick-or Treat on Canal Street on November 1, 2014. Possible recommendations to the Council.

Motion by Hanke/Mason to vote on the extension of premises for each business separately. **All present voting aye, motion carried.**

Motion by Hanke/Olson to deny the extension of premises in relation to Burly's Tavern. **All present voting aye, motion carried.**

It was discussed that no alcohol will be served outside. Chief Stelter also suggested that lighted barricades be used at the intersection of Canal Street and Main Street. Councilor Hanke stated that the temporary extension of premises for the establishments would be contingent upon Council approval of Item #1.

Motion by Hanke/Olson to approve the temporary extension of premises for Sweeney's Bar & Grill for the event on November 1, 2014 for the hours of 5:00 pm - 10:30 pm. **All present voting aye, motion carried.**

Motion by Hanke/Mason to approve the temporary extension of premises for Dewey's Roadhouse for the event on November 1, 2014 for the hours of 5:00 pm - 10:30 pm. **All present voting aye, motion carried.**

Motion by Hanke/Olson to approve the temporary extension of premises for Weekend at Bernie's for the event on November 1, 2014 for the hours of 5:00 pm - 10:30 pm. **All present voting aye, motion carried.**

3. Adjournment

Motion by Mason/Olson to adjourn at 8:18 pm. **All present voting aye, motion carried.**

The area would be the end of Woodward Ave. where stop sign is to the end of Sweeney's property on Canal St. Also requesting to close Canal St. from Main St. to Depot St. to vehicular traffic. Saw horses and cones will be provided by city department for all intersections on Canal. 5 ft high snow fencing will be used to close off perimeter. See diagram. There will be 2 ID checkpoints. One will be an opening in fencing by stop sign and the other will be Woodward Ave. entrance of Sweeney's. We will have employees checking id's at these checkpoints. We will also armband all patrons that have provided proper ID showing they are of the legal age to drink alcohol. Having these checkpoints and armbands prevents any underage persons from purchasing and consuming alcohol on our premises.





