Committee #1 - Revenues, Disbursements, Water and Wastewater met on Monday, July 18, 2016 at 9:00 AM in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 30 West Central Street, Chippewa Falls, WI.

Committee Members present: Rob Kiefer, John Monarski, Brent Ford.

Mayor/Other Council Members present: Paul Nadreau.

Others present: Finance Manager/Treasurer Lynne Bauer, City Clerk Bridget Givens, City Engineer/Public Works Director/Utilities Manager Rick Rubenzer, Street & Utility Maintenance Manager Rick Ruf, Assistant City Engineer Rob Krejci, Head Custodian Scot Michels, Kevin Erickson from LaCrosse Sign Co.,

Call to Order: 9:00 AM

1. Discuss funding for Police Sergeant Promotion. Possible recommendations to the Council.

The Committee considered Committee #2's recommendation to place the newly promoted Police Sergeant at Grade 14 Midpoint. Other sergeants have been placed at midpoint at the time of their promotion. Funding is in the 2016 Budget.

Motion by Monarski/Kiefer to recommend the Council approve funding for the Sergeant Promotion at Grade 14 Midpoint. **All present voted aye. Motion carried.**

2. Review design for City Hall sign and discuss funding for sign and flag pole lighting. Possible recommendations to the Council.

Kevin from LaCrosse Sign Co. presented two options for the final sign design. One option included black lettering and the other option blue lettering. Discussion included whether or not the address should be lit at an additional cost of \$105.00. The Committee preferred the blue option.

Motion by Monarski/Ford to recommend the Council approve the original bid of \$4,420. **All present voted aye. Motion carried.**

3. Discuss disposition of city vehicles and use of proceeds. Possible recommendations to the Council.

Committee Chair Rob Kiefer suggested the City look at the vehicle fleet as a whole and consider the police vehicles as part of that fleet. A brief discussion included whether or not to include the police vehicles in the fleet and how it would affect future budgets. Any funds from the disposition of city vehicles would be placed in a fleet replacement account. It was suggested that a sub-committee be formed to address the fleet policy as well as replacement of vehicles in the fleet. It was also determined that the appropriate committees for policy and street department equipment would be #2 and #3.

Motion by Kiefer/Ford to recommend the Council approve Council Committees #2 and #3 work together to create a fleet policy/plan. **All present voted aye. Motion carried.**

4. Adjournment.

Motion by Ford/Monarski to adjourn at 9:14 AM. **All present voted aye. Motion carried.**






