Transportation, Construction, Public Safety and Traffic

**Committee #3 met Tuesday, September 3, 2013 at 9:00 a.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers, 30 West Central Street, Chippewa Falls, WI.**

Council/Committee Members present: Bill Hicks, Jane Lardahl, and George Adrian

Absent: Mike Hanke

Others present: Police Chief Wendy Stelter, City Director of Public Works/City Engineer/Utilities Manager Rick Rubenzer, City Clerk Bridget Givens, and Heather Marble of Sweeney's Bar & Grill.

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 am.

- 1. Discuss request from Colleen Johnson from Sweeney's Bar & Grill for a temporary extension of premises in relation to their current Alcohol Beverage License Application for a benefit to be held on September 21, 2013. Possible recommendations to Council.**

A request was received to temporarily extend the licensed premises of Sweeney's Bar & Grill for a cancer benefit (see attached request). Heather Marble of Sweeney's Bar & Grill advised that employees will be checking I.D.'s at two designated entry points and that those of legal drinking age will receive an armband to prevent underage persons from purchasing or consuming alcohol.

The description of the requested area to be licensed would be the end of Woodward Avenue, adjacent to Sweeney's Bar & Grill, from the stop sign to the dumpster - leaving the alley and Canal Street open to traffic.

**Motion by Hicks/Lardahl** to recommend Council approve the request from Colleen Johnson from Sweeney's Bar & Grill for a temporary extension of premises in relation to their current Alcohol Beverage License Application for a benefit to be held on September 21, 2013. **All present voting aye, motion carried.**

- 2. Discuss Street Use Permit Application from Colleen Johnson from Sweeney's Bar & Grill for a benefit to be held on the Woodward Avenue block adjacent to the bar on September 21, 2013. Possible recommendations to Council.**

The Street Use Permit Application requests closing off the street to have a table, tent, food, and band in the area described. It was proposed that the area be enclosed with a snow fence and Street Department barricades. Councilor Hick's primary concern is the band and wanted to ensure the applicant was aware that if they are approached by neighboring homeowners regarding the noise, they would have to lower the volume. If approval is granted, no nuisance laws would be suspended.

Chief Stelter advised Ms. Marble to talk with neighbors in advance, and provide them with a number to call if there are any issues with noise the day of the event.

**Motion by Hicks/Lardahl** to recommend Council approve the Street Use Permit Application from Colleen Johnson from Sweeney's Bar & Grill for a benefit to be held on the Woodward Avenue block adjacent to the bar on September 21, 2013 with the condition that Sweeney's is responsive to their neighbors regarding complaints and with the understanding that no nuisance laws will be suspended. **All present voting aye, motion carried.**
