How it all started....

In 2013 a group of community volunteers consisting of a DNR Warden, a Rod and Gun Club member, and a YMCA instructor were brought together to help put on a Learn To Fish event in Chippewa Falls. Following the success of that event, two of the organizers began discussing how there were very few good off shore fishing areas in Chippewa Falls. That winter the group began to look for local areas that could be improved to allow more access to all members of the community. In the spring of 2014 Fish Chippewa! Met for the first time to begin plans for improving the site known as Erickson Park. With the help of Special Friends, Inc. funds were donated to hire Ayres Associates to draft the first

sketches of what would eventually become the Erickson Park All Access Fishing Pier and Park!
