The Chippewa Falls Parks and Recreation Department will be running a Men's Basketball League this Fall/Winter. Enclosed in this packet is information regarding league details & rules, and registration fees & rosters.

Men's Basketball

When: Wednesday Nights, October 16th, 2019 – March 2020
Game start times will vary dependent on availability of facilities.

Where: Chippewa Falls Middle School and High School

Registration Deadline: Friday, October 4th (League capped at 20 teams due to facility availability)

Registration Fee: \$300 - **due Friday, October 4th with Registration Form/Rosters**

Team Fee: \$160/ team – **due Friday, October 4th**
Late Fee: \$50 if paid after Oct. 25th/Team will be a "bye" on the schedule until paid

Rosters: Please fill out information completely and neatly!
Eligible players are at least 18 years old & not in High School

League Meeting: **TBD (emailed to registered managers)**
This is a MANDATORY meeting to play in the league. Each team must be represented. All communication for this league is emailed to team managers whom are responsible for communicating with their team.

Schedule Requests: Schedule requests will be considered and followed to the best of the offices ability. In the event of rescheduling cancellations requests may not be followed. Requests are NOT Guaranteed!

Men's Basketball Rules

1. Basketballs will be provided by Parks and Recreation. If both teams agree to use a different ball that is fine. *If theft of balls becomes a problem, teams will have to supply their own balls.*
2. NO grace time – If a team does not have enough eligible players to start a game at the scheduled time, they will be given a forfeit loss.
3. **Players MUST have numbered jerseys.**
 - a. **Player numbers must be written on the score sheets when you arrive at the courts. Score sheets must list players on your roster only.**
4. You MUST have at least 4 ROSTERED PLAYERS to start or the game is a forfeit loss. Teams may NEVER play with 3 players.
5. Any team that forfeits two games during the scheduled season will not be permitted to continue to play in the league. Teams scheduled to play this team will receive a forfeit victory.
6. If you bring your children along, they MUST stay in the gym under your supervision.
7. Concerns regarding the officials should be directed to the Parks & Rec Office. **DO NOT COMPLAIN TO THE OFFICIAL. Any altercations on and off the court could result in suspensions and/or termination from the league.**
8. No weapons or tobacco products on school property. In order to use tobacco products, you must completely leave School District property – this includes parking lots.
9. The league will follow WIAA Rules with the following exceptions:
 - a. 20-minute halves – clock stops the last 2 minutes of each half and on all time outs
 - b. Two (2) time-outs per half
 - c. (1) Three-minute overtime (League Play). Sudden death overtime period if game is still tied. Can end on a free throw if foul occurs
 - d. Bonus on 8th foul
 - e. Double bonus on 10th foul
 - f. Dunking is allowed
 - g. TECHNICAL FOULS
 - i. Players who receive a technical foul will not be allowed to play for the remainder of the ½ in which it occurred.
 - ii. If you receive 2 technical fouls in the same game you will not be allowed to play in the following game.
 - iii. Players who have 3 technical fouls throughout the season will be suspended from the league for the rest of the year
 - iv. Technical Fouls count toward team fouls
 - v. There does not need to be a “warning” before a technical is issued.
 - vi. Referees have discretion to eject players if deemed necessary. Respect your referees!
10. **Players in the end of the year tournament games need to have played in at least one regular season game during the year to be eligible.** If caught using players who did not play in a regular season game it will result in a forfeit loss. (All players must be on your roster. Anyone who is not on the roster will not be allowed to play).
